Update: COVID Vaccination Passport Requirements

On September 7, 2021 the Government of BC announced the details for the Vaccine Card Program that will go into effect September 13th.

The COVID-19 vaccination card allows those who meet the vaccination thresholds to gain admittance to non-essential activities. The idea is that by allowing vaccinated individuals access to non-essential services with proof of vaccination, additional restrictions like limits on capacities and closures will eventually be avoided.

Who has to use the vaccine passport?

The vaccination passport is required for everyone age 12 and older as follows:

- a) Residents of British Columbia, 12 to 18 years of age, must provide official confirmation, in either electronic or paper format;
- b) Residents of British Columbia, 19 years of age or older, must provide official confirmation in electronic format, or in paper format accompanied by government issued photo identification, such as a BC Services Card, a driver's licence, or a passport;
- c) Person who is a resident of another Canadian province or territory must provide official confirmation in electronic format, or in paper format issued by the person's province or territory of residence, accompanied by photo identification issued by the person's province or territory of residence, such as a driver's licence, or a passport;
- d) A person who is a resident of a country other than Canada must provide the proof of vaccination which was required in order for the person to enter Canada, and the person's passport, or other photo identification issued by the person's country of residence.

What restaurant types are required to check vaccine cards?

The following foodservice businesses are required to check vaccination cards for their patrons, inside and outside:

- a) Licensed restaurants and restaurants that offer table service (indoor and patio dining)
- b) Pubs, bars and lounges (indoor and patio dining)

How will this affect you at Chilliwack Golf Club?

All Members and Non-Members (**vaccinated or un-vaccinated**) will have access to the following areas:

- a) Golf Course
- b) Golf Shop
- c) Outdoor Wedding Ceremony Site

- d) Concession Stand (1st & 10th tee) & Beverage Cart
- e) Clubhouse Washrooms

Members and Non-Members who are **VACCINATED** will have access to the above areas, in addition to the:

- a) Creekside Lounge
- b) Creekside Patio
- c) Mnt. Cheam Room
- d) Canex Pavilion (licensed patio)

If a patron (Member and Non-Members) is unable to produce a valid vaccine passport and supporting government issued ID, the patron will not be granted access to these areas.

Patrons attending events in the Canex Pavilion or Mnt. Cheam Room will be required to wear a wristband or have their hand stamped once their passport and ID has been validated.

Please Note: Provincial mask orders are still in effect. Masks must be worn at all times in any indoor public space when not seated at a table.
