Head Golf Professional, Ryan Tofani and your advisory committee are happy to announce the start of the Men's Night season on April 5th.

Men's Night Basic Information:

- Cash will "NOT" be accepted for Men's Night Check-In. Account Charge for Members *ONLY*
- Credit or Debit Payment for Guests & Public
- Cash will be accepted for "GROSS SKINS"
- Cash will be accepted for "WORLD BEATER"
- Men's Night will be an 18-hole first tee start, intervals will be 9 minutes.
- First tee time is 10:30 AM in April & September, last tee time being 4:00 PM
- First tee time is 10:30 AM in May, June, July & August, last tee time being 5:00 PM
- There will be on-course "competitions" (IE: Closest to the Pin, Long Putt, Closest to the Pin in 2)
- There will be Net and Gross divisional prizes being paid out by credit book. Gift Cards for Guests.
- Reminder that alcohol is not permitted to be brought to Chilliwack Golf Club.
- All 18 holes must be completed to qualify for any prizing including KP, SKINS, WORLD BEATER, GROSS & NET PRIZING. Any "WD" is considered an incomplete round and will not qualify. No refunds will be given for any of the above games. Men's Night is a competition after all!
- "NO GIMMIES" All putts must be made to complete/post a score

MEN'S NIGHT RULES, COMPETITIONS AND PRIZES

Men's Night Season:

- Opening Day: First Wednesday of April
- Ending Day: Last Wednesday in September
- Wrap Up: First Wednesday of October

Men's Night Schedule:

- Men's Night is an 18 Hole competition
 - 18 Holes Tee Times
- Iron Man is on the last Wednesday of each month starting in May, there will be no Ironman in April. (Gold Tee's, except #13, please tee off of the blue box regardless of where the tee's are.)

Men's Night Entrance Fee Members:

- \$20 per player (no tax)
- \$20 for Optional Gross Skins Game (Cash ONLY, open to all participants including Pro's & Staff)
- \$10 "World Beater". Low Gross takes the entire pot, open to all participants including Staff & Professionals. (Professionals & Staff must play in World Beater to participate in Gross Skins)

Guest Fees:

- \$74 (no tax)
- Includes Green Fee and Men's Night Entrance Fee
- Note: Guests are not included in FedEx Cup
- All guests must play in the "Guest Division" (even if they have a Golf Canada index)
- Guest division will have net and gross prizes
- Guests are encouraged to play in Gross Skins & World Beater

Handicap Requirements:

Member participants must meet the following criteria:

- Members must have a valid and accurate Golf Canada index. Handicap cutoff is Tuesday evening at 6:00 PM.
- Members must have a minimum of 8 recorded rounds of golf in the past 10 months
- Members must record all recent rounds of golf with Golf Canada
- The Men's Night Committee and CGC Handicap Committee will review entered scores each week
- All Men's Night & other scores must be entered within 24 hours (all scores for that matter)
- Failure to meet the above expectations will result in the member being required to participate in the Guest Division.

- **Weekly Registration/Sign-In:**
- Registration is in the Golf Shop
- All tee times will be made via online booking from the membership, no preferred tee times or advanced booking for Men's Night, unless you are a sponsor and using your advanced booking foursome.
- Flights will be recorded in Golf Genius Scoring Application
- Golf Shop staff record name and verify handicap
- Golf Shop collect fee and process through POS
- Optional Gross Skins Game money is CASH ONLY
- Optional World Beater is CASH ONLY
- Members are to pay Account Charge ONLY
- Guests are to pay via Debit or Credit
- Registration numbers are verified and counted after the last registrant and compared to scoring results to ensure numbers match

Allocation of Entrance Fee:

- \$12 Weekly Gross and Net Prizes per Division
- \$2 Weekly Net Skins
- \$2 FedEx Cup (Only applicable for Members)
- \$2 End of Season Dinner Banquet
- \$1 Progressive Blind Net Skins
- \$1 Progressive Hole in One on #4 (**Members will be paid out on "CLUB ACCOUNT", Guests will be paid in a "GIFT CARD" format when the pot is won.**)

Weekly Prizing:

- **Four Handicap Flights *Subject to change based on #'s in each flight***
- **+Handicap-4**
- **5-8**
- **9-12**
- **13+**
- Guest Flight
- One Guest Flight (with or without a Golf Canada index) No Index means "0" Handicap
- Gross and Net Prizes per Division
- Three Gross and Three Net Prizes are awarded per flight including Guest
- Net Skins are awarded.
- On Course Competitions per Flight: 1 KP, 1 LP, 1 KP IN 2
- Optional Gross Skins game awarded
- Optional World Beater game
- FedEx Cup points are awarded each week (see below for more information)

Scoring:

- Scoring is completed using Golf Genius software
- All Men's Night participants are entered into the system and a profile is created
- Golf Genius is used to track weekly and season long results
- Golf Genius numbers (# of golfers) are compared to registration number on Flight sheets and to POS reports. Determine if anyone is missing from registration. These numbers must all match!
- Reports are generated and posted in the Men's Locker Room and online

Iron Man:

- All participants play from the Gold Tees
- Hole #13 – the Gold tee is moved up to the normal Blue tee box area in case they are not please play from the Blue Tee Box.
- The Low Gross Winner of each flight wins a "seat" in the season end shoot-out
- There is no IronMan for the month of April, May through September only.

Season End Wrap Up Party:

- First Wednesday of October
- Dinner, Door Prizes, Prize Package Draw's, 50/50 Draw
- Dinner Menu: determined by HP, GM, Chef
- Dinner is subsidized based on number of Men's Night played in during the season
 - 24+ GAMES: Free
 - 19 TO 23 GAMES: \$15
 - 14 TO 18 GAMES: \$20
 - 9 TO 13 GAMES: \$30
 - 4 TO 8 GAMES: \$40
 - 0 TO 3 GAMES: \$60
- Everyone who attends will receive one raffle ticket for each Men's Night they've played
- Cash for 50/50
- 4PM Shootout begins
- 6PM Registration & Cocktails
- 7PM Dinner
- Draw Prizes: Each person is entitled to win one draw prize per night. Any repeat winners, will be drawn again. You can win multiple heads or tails games if you have paid for it.



Men's Night FedEx Cup

A season-long **PGA Tour FedEx Cup** style points race. Divisions are broken down into the following categories: **+ Handicap-4, 5-8, 9-12 & 13+ Handicap** (there is no guest division for the FedEx Cup). Each week you play, depending on your finish within your division you will earn points just like the PGA Tour. FedEx Cup points are based on **Net Results**.

April 5th through May 17th you can flip flop divisions, you must know which division you are in before teeing off for all prizing purposes. There is no IronMan for the month of April!

Third Wednesday in May (May 24th) your current handicap from the blue tee's will determine the division you will be locked into for the remainder of the season and you will start earning FedEx points. Our FedEx Finale with Bonus Points will take place last week of September at which point in time we will determine our overall divisional winners. Once you are locked into a division you are locked in, including prizes, KP's, IronMan. ***WHATEVER DIVISION YOU ARE LOCKED INTO IS WHAT DIVISION YOU PLAY IN THE FOR WHOLE SEASON***

Men's Night Entrance Fee of \$20 includes: entrance into the FedEx Cup, On Course Competitions, weekly Net & Gross Payouts by Division, Net Skins, End of Season Prizes, Progressive Prizes & Wrap Up Dinner Banquet (the more you participate the lower your price). An optional \$20 Gross Skin game will also be available each week. \$10 Gross World Beater Game is also optional for all players. All prizes are paid out by credit book or gift cards for guests. Guests can participate in all prizing except for the season-long FedEx Cup. You must have played in either two Men's Nights or have five posted rounds before you are locked into a division. Otherwise, the committee has the right to move you once you've been locked in.

Guests are encouraged to participate in Men's Night each week. **Guest price is \$74** no tax and includes green fee and entrance fee into the Men's Night prizes.

A reminder to anyone using a "Guest Pass" on a Men's Night, your green fee is looked after but your \$20 entrance fee for Men's Night is not included.

FedEx Prizing will be paid out at the end of the season. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th Place will all receive a Golf Shop Credit Book Prize on their Account.

FedEx Cup standings and Men's Night results are updated on a weekly basis and will be available online and in the Men's Locker Room. Any questions about the format or point distribution can be directed to Head Golf Professional Ryan Tofani.
